Your pet is here for anesthesia/surgery and should do fine. Prior to anesthesia we will perform a full Physical exam assess his/her state of health. However, pre-existing conditions not evident in a pre-surgical exam can and/or lead t
unforeseen complications. This is why we <u>highly recommend</u> the procedures listed below:
<u>Pre-anesthetic blood panel</u> to screen for any liver or kidney problems that could interfere with anesthetic recovery
The cost for this procedure is \$88.50. (Mandatory for pets over 7 years. \$172.50)

I.V. Catheter placed preoperatively giving us the means to quickly treat any complications, which may arise. This is
required with certain procedures. The cost for this is \$54.75.

Laser Surgery is used for a wide variety of surgical procedures (decreases bleeding, seals the nerve endings) resultir
in much less pain and allows for faster recovery. The additional cost for this is \$72.75.
Post-Op Laser (Therapeutic) is used to speed up the healing process and decrease pain. The additional cost for this \$24.00.
Post-operative Pain Management Please give my pet an additional pain reliever after surgery. I am aware the cost
for this is \$35.00 (dependent on weight)

Do you wish your pet to go home with oral medications for continued pain management during recovery from this procedure?

Pre-operative Anti-Nausea
Please give my pet additional injection to help relieve nausea that can be associated with anesthetic medications before surgery. I am aware the cost for this is \$61.50 if my pet is under 70lbs and \$84.65 if over 70lbs.

You may also elect to have your pet micro-chipped while he/she under anesthesia. You will be able to have your per information registered into a national database to aid in identification and recovery should your pet ever become
lost. The cost for this is \$65.00.
You may also elect to radiograph your pet's hips while he/she is under anesthesia. This will help us accurately
evaluate conformation and screen for signs of dysplasia. The cost for this is \$266.25. Yes No ** I understand there are inherent risks with anesthesia/surgery and will not hold Sugar Hill Animal Hospital responsible for unseen complications.
